



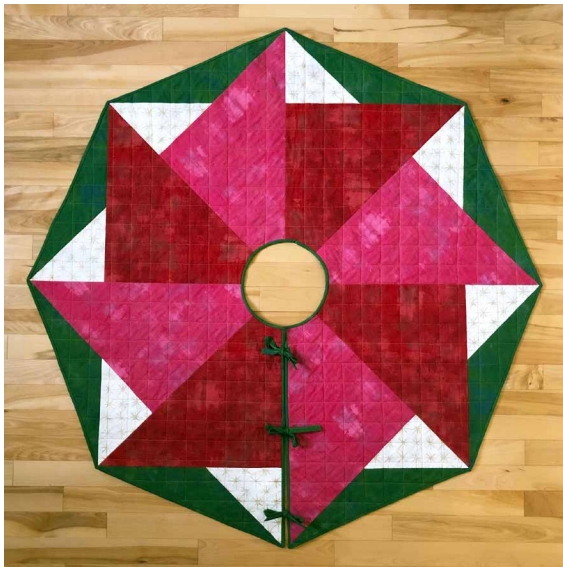

Spinning Star Tree Skirt - 21" Diameter

The full 54" Spinning Star Tree Skirt pattern is [available here](#). To make a 21" diameter tree skirt, use the materials and cutting instructions below. Follow the remaining instructions in the pattern to complete the tree skirt.

Note: Fat Quarters are assumed to be at least 17" x 20", and Fat Eighths at least 8" x 20".



Materials Needed

	21" diameter
Main A	Fat Quarter
Main B	Fat Quarter
Accent	Fat Eighth
Background	Fat Quarter
Backing	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard
Batting	27" x 27"
Binding*	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard

* You will need ~100" of bias binding.

Cutting

1. From Main A fabric, cut (2) $8\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square once along the diagonal to make 4 right triangles. Repeat with Main B fabric.
2. From Accent fabric, cut (4) 4" squares. Cut each square once along the diagonal to make 8 right triangles.
3. From Background fabric, cut (4) $9" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ rectangles. With the rectangle oriented lengthwise, cut once along the diagonal from upper left to lower right to make 8 right-pointing right triangles.
4. On each Background triangle, measure $3\frac{3}{8}"$ up and $3\frac{3}{8}"$ right from the bottom left corner. Make a small mark or crease at each point. Align a ruler with the two marks and make a 45-degree cut. The elongated triangle is the Background piece; discard the small triangle.
